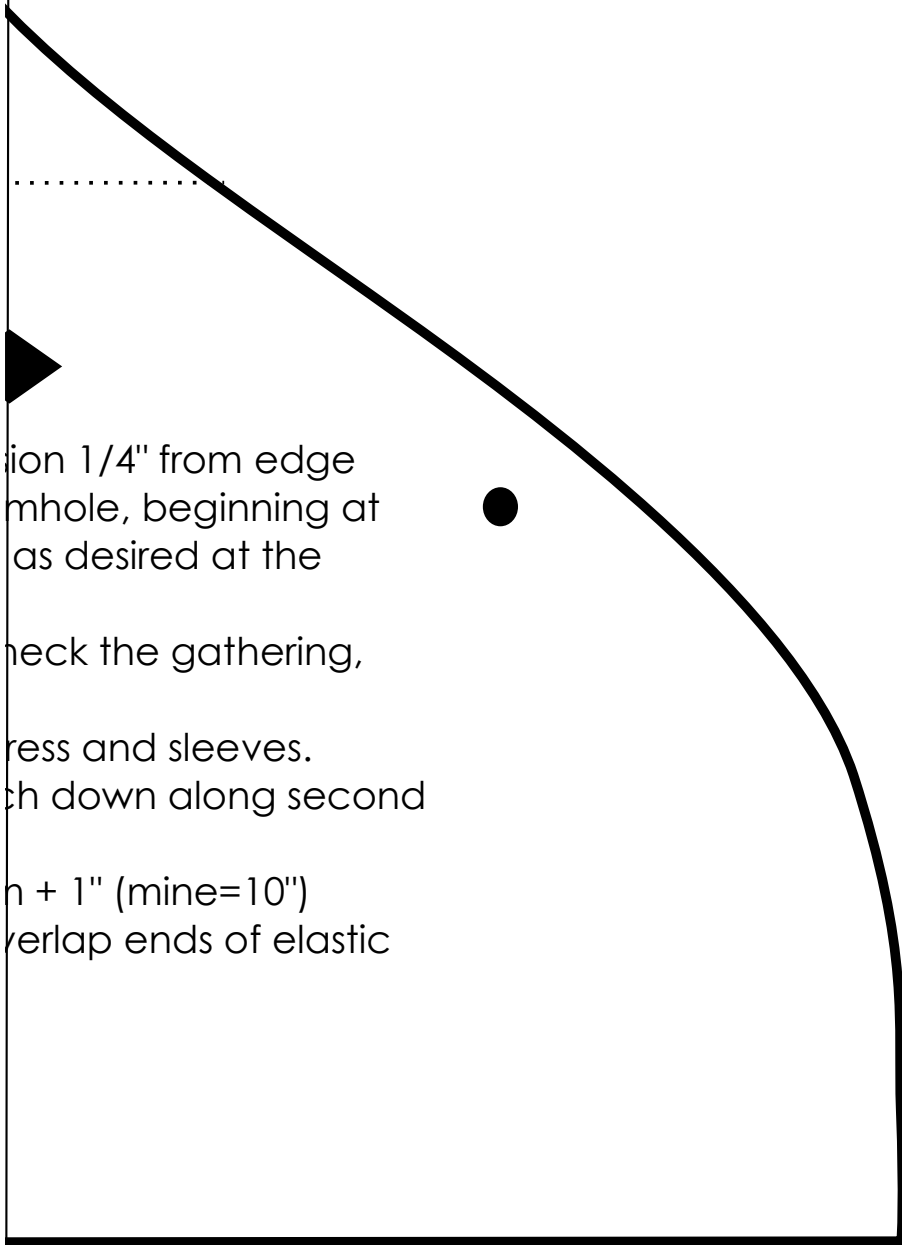

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut two sleeves on the fold
2. Transfer dots to fabric with marking pen
3. Gather between dots using a long stitch length and high tens
4. After sewing shoulder seam on dress (Step 5), pin sleeve to armhole at the armpits and moving toward the center, adjusting gathering toward shoulder. Right sides should be facing.
5. Sew together with a 1/2" seam. I like to machine baste first, check fit, and then re-sew with a normal stitch length.
6. Attach facings (or linings if desired), then sew side seams of dress
7. Press under 1/4" at bottom of sleeve, then again 1/2" and stitch together to form an elastic casing, leaving 1" open to thread elastic.
8. Cut a length of 1/4" elastic long enough to circle your forearm
9. Using a safety pin, thread the 1/4" elastic through opening, over the casing, and stitch together. Sew casing shut.
